## **Eucalyptus longhorn beetle**

- Insect name: Eucalyptus longhorn beetle
- Causal agents: Phorocantha recurva and P. semipunctata
- Trees affected: *Eucalyptus* spp.
- Feeding: Wood borer
- Symptoms: Cracks on bark; tunnels under bark, filled with frass; cylindrical white larvae (up to 32 mm) with enlarged front section, under bark or in sapwood
