Internship in Phytochemistry

The intern will gain experience in:

- preparing plant samples for extraction of organic molecules
- extracting organic molecules using different techniques
- analysing metabolites using liquid and gas chromatography coupled to mass spectrometry
- analysing and interpreting analytical data using different software solutions and metabolomics platforms

Eligibility and stipends:

- South African graduates with a minimum of a BSc Hons degree or a four-year BSc Agric degree. These may include specialization in a range of fields in the natural and biological sciences (e.g. chemistry, biochemistry, soil sciences and botany).
- Preferred applicants are those whose appointment would contribute towards achieving demographic representation in FABI.
- This is a six-month full-time internship with a monthly stipend of at least R 8000, depending on the student's academic qualifications.
- The Internship will start in July 2022 and run for a six month period.
