## HOW TO SUBMIT

1. Identify diseased plants and symptoms.
2. Take photographs.
3. Collect samples.
4. Send samples soon after collection while the samples are fresh.

**Note:** No samples will be processed without a completed form.

## SUBMISSION TIPS

- ✓ Collect plant tissue where the primary symptoms are present but ensure that there is also some healthy plant tissue present on the sample you collect. Plant material that is already in an advance state of disease and/or too dry will be overgrown with secondary fungi and as such will not allow for the identification of the primary pathogen.
- ✓ Soil samples should be between 300 – 500 grams.
- ✓ Soil should always accompany root samples.
- ✓ Samples should be individually wrapped, labelled and placed in brown paper or plastic bags.
- ✓ Insect specimens should be sent in 70% ethanol or surgical spirits in a liquid tight container.
