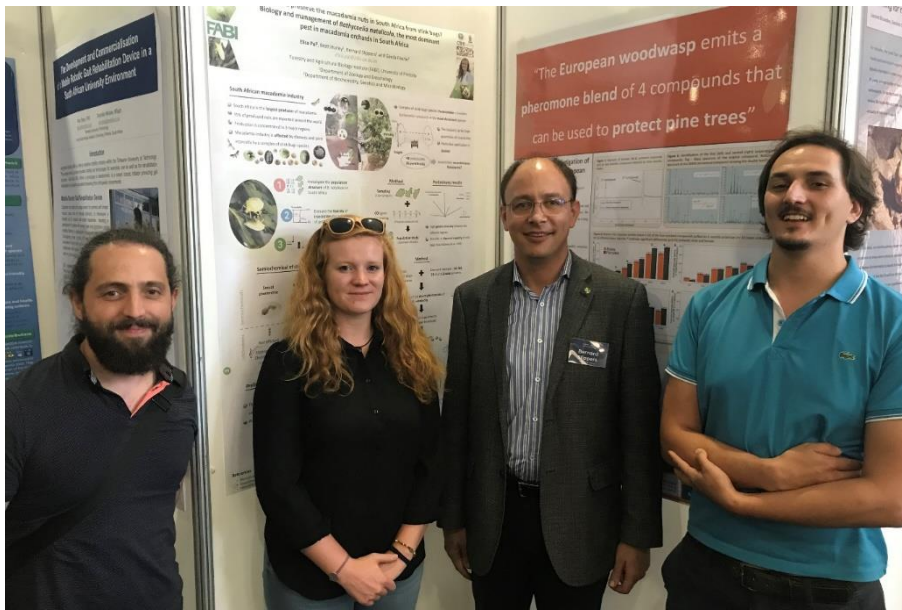


FABIANS FEATURE AT THE FRENCH-SA SCIENCE AND INNOVATION DAYS
