

# Poplar emperor moth

Insect name: Poplar emperor moth

Causal agents: *Pseudoburnea irius*

Trees affected: *Acacia*  
*Eucalyptus*  
*Pinus*

Feeding: Defoliator

Symptoms: Feeding on leaves; stunted growth; large caterpillars (up to 65 mm)
